As always, it's a great privilege for us to be able to write and tell of the works the Lord nis doing in this ministry. We know it's been a few months since our last update and to tell the truth, there has a been a lot going on here so we'll get

right into it.

before Christmas Right partnered with a church, we help from time to time in a small village called Kini. A few years ago, pastor Miguel and his church God is Good Baptist had a small bible study in this small village and from the pandemic it basically fell away. We agreed to go there with some of our people and some of his people and do some evangelism. As we were setting up it began to rain hard, and so as we all scattered and sought shelter, the people that had gathered with us were all under a roofed porch area of the local govt building. So, we had the kid's activity, and to one side I was able to speak with several adults and by God's grace some were saved. In the course of our time there an elderly woman approached me and indicated that she was from another village, not too far away and said that she would like someone to come to her village and preach the word of God. We immediately called pastor Miguel over and they set up a time to go and visit

with her in her village. Pastor Miguel and people from his church have been going to this village every Sunday since that time. After a few months of services there, they have seen several families come together, about 30 people saved and in

February they are going to have some baptisms. Our church has been invited to go and participate. which is a blessing. God is working and souls are being saved.

In our own ministries, we had a great Christmas program at the church with our choir singing

> a cantata, our Sunday morning service was well attended and we had some visitors with a lady coming forward for salvation.

> > In our village works, we combined our 2 villages for the first time and it was a good time.

We had a big fellowship with about 150 in attendance, gifts for the children and food after the service. Several people indicated they had trusted Christ as Saviour, and we rejoice for what the Lord has been doing in our villages churches.

We also were able to build roof over our children's area in one of our village churches. Our cloth covering blew away in a storm. But now we have a sold metal structure that we trust will withstand any storms.

Thank you all for your faithfulness to this ministry, for co laboring with us in our calling and we rejoice for the fruit we are able to add to your account, to God be the glory!
