Greetings,

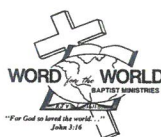
It's always a privilege to write you with an update from the Yucatan Peninsula as we serve together for the furtherance of the gospel.

Our fall season brings us a full calendar, we often have church groups visiting and then we move into our annual Leadership Conference which is a great time of ministry for our church as we host many local pastors to come and hear the word of God.

In October we had a church visiting from Colorado, where we were able to organize an evangelistic campaign in a municipality about an hour away. Our church supports a missionary there who ministers in the Mayan dialect that is spoken in our part of Mexico. We were able to distribute 10,000 John and Romans and we saw just about 100 people come to the meeting where our guest pastor preached in Spanish and our missionary translated into Mayan. We saw some 27 souls saved, and 30 bibles handed out for free. It was a great day and we rejoiced for the work of God we all had a part in. This same group while visiting the local coffee shop in the morning invited a young lady who works there, and she has come to our church services the last few weeks.

In the final days of October we hold our Leadership Conference, this year our theme was Renew. There was excellent preaching and some great sessions in the morning. Also, we were able to gift each pastor with a package of soul winning material that they could take back to their church and train their own people to own the great commission in their area.

Also please continue to pray about our 2nd floor situation, we are planning on resubmitting our plans since there is a new administration in place now.



Earlier this year we hosted a ministry called Campaigns for Christ, where we were able to involve some local churches in a great evangelistic effort that resulted in many souls saved and a new Baptist Church being formed. Next year they are returning for some more campaigns, and we have helped them to work with some more national pastors we know.
